KEY UPDATE: FOCUS ON RETURNEES

After a series of video calls with DC Changlang, SDM Tiruppur and the stranded Arunachalese migrant workers during 1^s and 2nd week of June that team CRDO had organized, it is very fulfilling to inform that the administration has arranged 2 trains on 16th and 18th from Chennai to Dibrugarh facilitating 330 migrants come back home. We must strengthen our focus now on the ground and ensure that the returnees are accommodated and taken care of. While 7 new cases were reported, 13 were discharged yesterday.

INCOMING RETURNEES

A huge contingent of 157 returnees arrived yesterday from Tiruppur at around midnight. The EAC Diyun was awake till wee hours and led from the front to supervise the operations. The process involves massive work from the administration to do screening, transportation and allocating people to various QCs based on availability. The medical team and health workers are doing a great job on the ground managing collection of swabs and attending to needs of inmates. Note that a few Arunachalese migrants are also returning from other cities back home in small batches.

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

- Please note the revised SOP for returnees: all stranded returnees are advised to return to the state by 30 June. After 1 July, the returnees shall have to bear the cost of institutional quarantine.
- Support Covid warriors /CRDO team/volunteers and administration and combat the spread of Corona virus together in solidarity with each other as a community.
- ❖ Since most of positive cases are found from those returning from Red Zones, it is important that those coming from Green Zones and Red zones are kept separately. Mix-up to be avoided.
- ❖ You may donate /contribute for our Covid-19 positive inmates in CCCs so that they get good immunity-boosting food to recover quickly. Thanks to SKS for financial contribution made towards CCC at Diyun MBS.
- ❖ Contact CRDO Helpline for any issues you see on the ground related to the management of the QCs. Returnees may report issues/ grievances to our team. Suggestions to improve QCs are also welcome.
